The John von Neumann Computer Society was founded in 1968.

Initially this Society was the first civil organization specialised in computer technology. Nowadays it works as a non-profit association serving wide layers of the information society.

The activity of the organization has been expanded by the continuous

development in informatics: this is because the professional communities dealing with artificial intelligence and education in informatics has been existing from the very beginnings. Digital Equal Opportunities (DE!) was not mentioned in the 70's, 80's years, but by today the name NJSZT has become one with it (DE!): the program includes the dissemination of computer skills, and aims to improve the quality of life as eVITA program.
